FOR HORSES ALREADY REGISTERED WITH ANOTHER REGISTRY (C.S.H.A. OR S.H.S.)

1. Horse must be registered with A.S.H.A. showing the same registered ownership as shown on C.S.H.A. or S.H.S. papers.
2. ASHA does not register horses for residents of Canada or England unless a US resident is a co-owner.
3. Ignore the "Certificate of Breeding section. Fill out all other portions of the application, including sketch and description on back. Sign as Owner (s).
4. Send original C.S.H.A. or S.H.S. papers with application and fees. Fees are the same as the fee to register a gelding, regardless of age or sex.

Be careful to spell names correctly and write plainly to avoid errors. Only the names and ASHA number are required when sires and dams are recorded in the American Shire Horse stud book.

In applying for registration of the above described animal, I/we understand that the pedigree will be accepted only on the condition that the foregoing particulars are correct and that if it should be ascertained that these particulars are in any way incorrect, the American Shire Horse Association may at its discretion, revoke the registration, omit the pedigree or publish it in an altered form. I/we further understand that, should the pedigree be published in the American Shire Horse Stud Book prior to the discovery of any error, the American Shire Horse Association shall not be held responsible for any loss or damage that may be sustained through the inaccuracy, omission or alteration of the above pedigree or cancellation of the entry.

WARNING ABOUT MAILING FALSE PEDIGREE OR TRANSFERS—Sending a fraudulent application for registration, a fraudulent transfer, or a fraudulent certificate of pedigree through the US mail with intent to defraud is a federal offense, subject to prosecution by the US government and punishable by fine, imprisonment, or both.

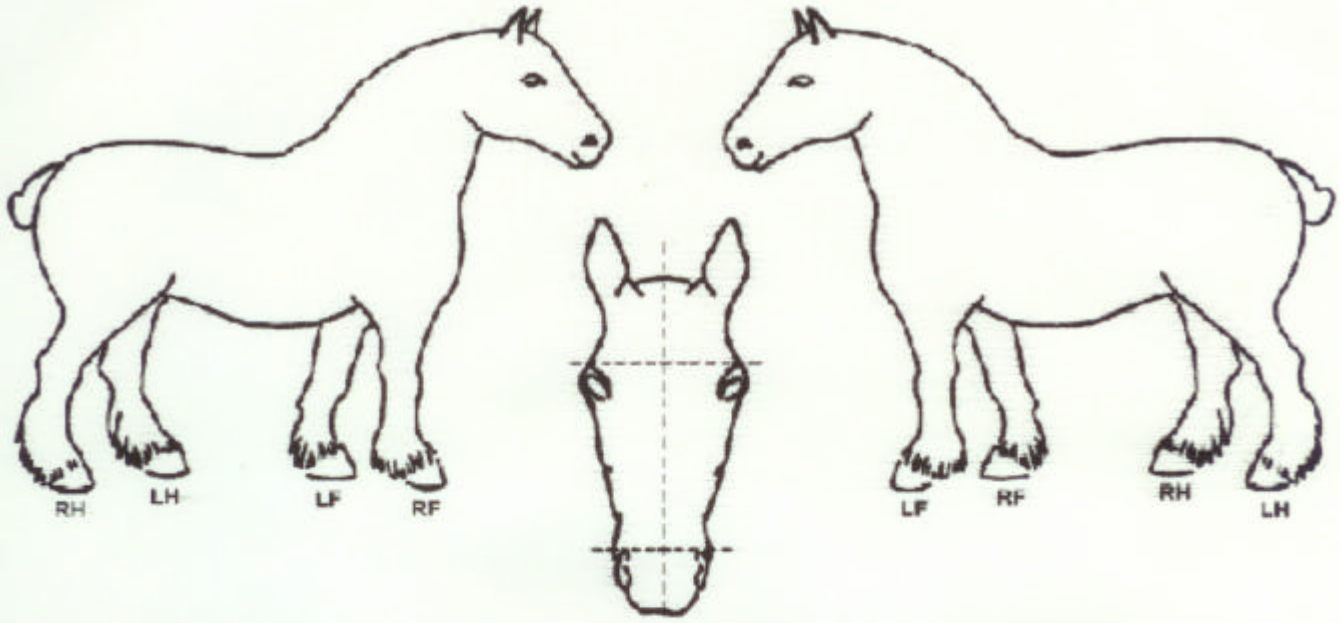
