

- Emailed digital photos are preferred, but color hard copies are acceptable.
 - o Label each photo or email with the name of the horse and the owner.
 - o If hard copies are submitted, label the back of each photo with the name of the horse and the owner.

Photo requirements:

- Must be in color.
- All parts of the horse must be visible in the photos (feet, ear tips, etc.).
- Horse must be clean enough to accurately show body color and white markings.
- Horse must be on a surface that allows clear view of the feet (asphalt, concrete, dry hard packed dirt. Grass, snow or mud may obscure markings).
- 4 current photographs are required:
 - Full front view of head and front of legs (1)
 - Forelock should be pulled to the side to clearly show face markings.
 - Left and right full side views (2 & 3)
 - Horse should be posed so that all four legs are visible in each side view (see example photo).
 - If there are white markings on the neck, the mane should be put over to opposite side so the markings show.
 - Full rear view (4)
 - If the horse's tail is long, tie it up or have someone hold it to the side so all leg markings are clearly visible.
 - **Note:** Additional photos should be submitted if the horse has white markings that do not show on the four standard photos (e.g., under jaw or under the barrel).
