



ASHA Youth Scholarship Rules and Requirements

Adopted January 2012 by the Youth Committee

Applicant Eligibility Requirements:

- 1) Must be an ASHA Youth Member, preference given to YAP Members
- 2) No requirements on type of college attending (ie short course, 2-yr, or 4-yr)
- 3) Must be a high school junior or senior
- 4) Applicants must prove their acceptance into a college before scholarship is awarded.
Note: If a junior is chosen, the scholarship money may not be awarded until the following year due not being accepted by a college at this time.
- 5) If winner does not provide proof of college acceptance within two years of recognition, the award is forfeited.
- 5) Scholarship applications are due by August 1st.
- 6) No limit on how many times an applicant may apply

Selection Process Rules:

- 1) Winner will be chosen by the Youth Committee by September 1st.
- 2) Short biography of winner will be published in the Fall Bulletin.
- 3) Payment to be made to winner in fall timeframe upon proof of college acceptance.
