- Send original CSHA or SHS papers with application and fees. Fees are the same as the fee to register a gelding, regardless of age or sex.

In applying for registration of the above animal, I/we understand that the pedigree will be accepted only on the condition that the foregoing particulars are correct and that if it should be ascertained that these particulars are in any way incorrect, the American Shire Horse Association may at its discretion, revoke the registration, omit the pedigree or publish it in an altered form. I/we further understand that, should the pedigree be published in the American Shire Horse Stud Book prior to the discovery of any error, the American Shire Horse Association shall not be held responsible for any loss or damage that may be sustained through the inaccuracy, omission or alteration of the above pedigree or cancellation of the entry.

(Required) Submit photographs clearly showing all markings on the horse. All parts of the horse must be seen in photographs, including tips of ears, nose, and all hooves. Do not “square” the horse’s legs for the photos. Send photographs along with the registration application or digitally to secretary@shirehorse.org Please include the name of the horse and the owner on the photographs or email.

Photos should include:

- 1) frontal head
- 2) left side
- 3) right side
- 4) rear
- 5) any other marking not visible in above photos (if applicable)

(Optional) If desired, you may also submit a written description (page 3) using correct terms:

Use the Federation Equestre Internationale (FEI) Identification of Horses with the Narrative and the diagram to assist you with markings.

- Emailed digital photos are preferred, but color hard copies are accepted. Label each photo or email with the name of the horse and the owner. If hard copies are submitted, label the back of each photo with the name of the horse and owner. Note: ASHA reserves the right to require additional photos for clarification.
- Must be in color.
- All parts of the horse must be visible in the photos (feet, ear tips, etc.).
- Horse must be clean enough to accurately show body color and white markings.
- Horse must be on a surface that allows clear view of the feet (asphalt, concrete, dry hard packed dirt. Grass, snow or mud may obscure markings).
- 4 current photographs are required:
 - (Photo 1) Full front view of head and front of legs. *Forelock should be pulled to the side to clearly show face markings.*
 - (Photo 2 & 3) Left and right full side views. *Horse should be posed so that all four legs are visible in each side view (see example photo). If there are white markings on the neck, the mane should be put over to opposite side so the markings show.*
 - (Photo 4) Full rear view. *If the horse's tail is long, tie it up or have someone hold it to the side so all leg markings are clearly visible.*
 - Additional photos should be submitted if the horse has white markings that do not show on the four standard photos (e.g., under jaw or under the barrel).

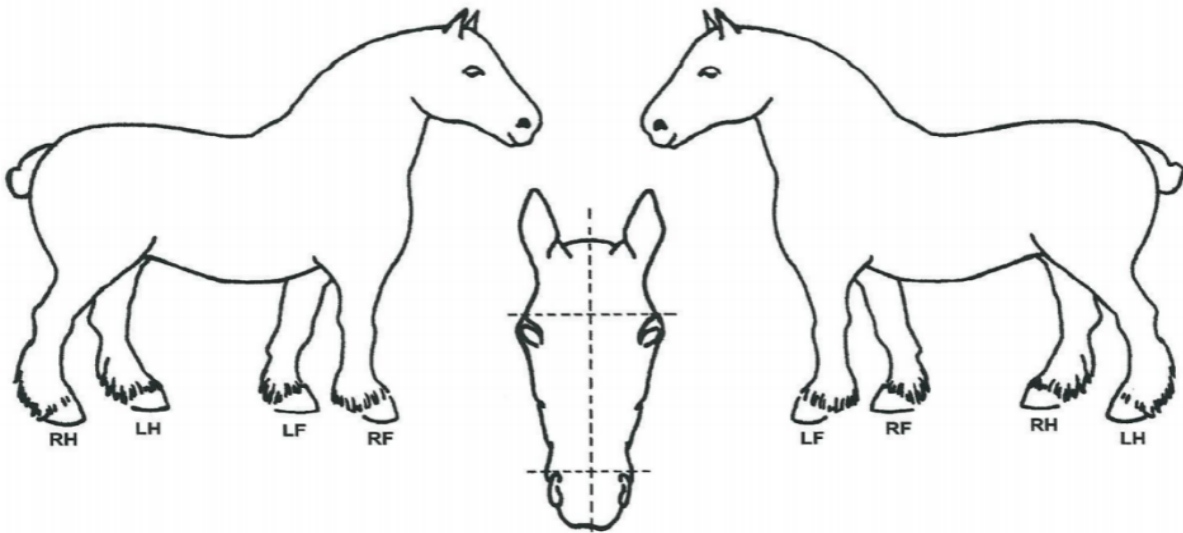
